



# Hites Family Foundation/Walt and Norma Fiedler Scholarship

Hites Family Foundation/Walt and Norma Fiedler Scholarship provides up to \$4,000 distributed over two years for graduates of Bismarck State College (BSC) to continue their studies at baccalaureate degree-granting colleges or universities. Criteria for the scholarship include a minimum of 50 semester hours completed at BSC at the time of transferring, a cumulative GPA average of 3.5 or better, and acceptance into and enrollment at an accredited four-year institution leading to a baccalaureate degree.

The recipient must be classified as a full-time student and must maintain that status throughout the semester to be eligible for renewal. Students must maintain a 2.75 GPA during the first semester (junior year) and a 3.0 cumulative GPA during each of the following semesters to receive payment for the next term. The scholarship award amount is up to \$2,000 per year for two years (payable at \$1,000 per semester).
