Am I required to quarantine?

<p>NDDoH recommendation:</p> <p>If you are fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and remain symptom-free, you do not need to quarantine or get tested for COVID-19 following your exposure as long as you remain asymptomatic.</p>	<p>NDDoH recommendation:</p> <p>At least 14 days from the last exposure to someone who tested positive for COVID-19</p> <p>You may be released from quarantine AFTER DAY 10 if the following criteria are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain symptom-free. <p>You may be released from quarantine AFTER DAY 7 if the following criteria are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remain symptom-free. Test negative for COVID-19 - please note that the PCR or antigen test must be administered day 5 or later. Free public testing throughout North Dakota is available to anyone who would like to be tested for COVID-19. Can I use the dining center on campus?

Can I still get tested for COVID-19?

Yes.	<p>NDDOH recommendation: It is not recommended you retest for COVID-19 within 90 days from your illness onset if you remain asymptomatic; test results during this time may remain residually positive. If you do become ill again, consult with your healthcare provider regarding your illness. If you would be exposed to COVID-19 again within 90 days of your illness onset, it is not recommended to quarantine for those exposures.</p>

Can I still get vaccinated for COVID-19? Where/who do they contact for vaccine info?

Not applicable. COVID Vaccine Locator	<p>NDDOH Recommendation: No. People who are quarantined because of exposure to COVID-19 should wait to be vaccinated until their quarantine period has ended. This is to prevent spread to COVID-19 vaccinators.</p> <p>COVID Vaccine Locator</p>	<p>NDDOH recommendation: Vaccination should be postponed until the person has recovered and criteria have been met to end isolation.</p> <p>There is not a minimum interval between infection and vaccination. However, current evidence suggests reinfection is uncommon in the 90 days after initial infection, and thus, persons with documented acute infection in the preceding 90 days may defer vaccination until the end of this period, if desired.
