BSC's Agriculture Department, along with industry partners, demonstrate the importance of relationships annually and recently hosted their annual **Round Table event**.





In partnership with the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (DPI), Bismarck State College is offering a cybersecurity credential to North Dakota K-12 teachers. The goal is to expand computer science and cybersecurity throughout K12 education and make all ND students Cyber-Smart.

The ND Department of Public Instruction's goal is to train teachers across the state to be able to incorporate computer science and cybersecurity into curriculum at all levels of secondary education. Through BSC's partnership with Palo Alto Networks, BSC is offering both credit and non-credit computer science and cybersecurity credentials.
