

Student Policy - President's Honor Roll

Policy:

At the conclusion of each semester, the President of Bismarck State College shall recognize students for academic achievement.

Students who have earned a 3.5 institutional grade point average while enrolled in 12 or more semester hours of Bismarck State College coursework with honor points for the semester/term will be named to the President's Honor Roll.

If the change of a final grade impacts academic honors, the update will be reflected on the student's transcript.
